The course of study has a regulated duration of 9 semesters and is divided into two parts. The first part leads to the certificate preliminary test (Diplom-Vorprüfung) and is regarded as a general degree programme.

The second part leads to the final examination (Diplom-Hauptprüfung) and is regarded as a specialization programme. At the end of the final examination the University awards the academic degree „Diplom-Pflege- und Gesundheitswissenschaftler“.

The degree „Diplom-Pflege- und Gesundheitswissenschaftler“ qualifies the candidate to continue her studies towards to a doctorate without compulsory postgraduate studies or any additional examinations.

The examination, however, does not qualify to practise the profession as a nurse.

According to a decision by the conference of German Ministers of Education (Kultusministerkonferenz – KMK) and on the recommendation of the Ministry of Education of Saxony-Anhalt, this degree is, in view of the wide scope and extent of the course of study and of the above-mentioned reasons, comparable to the Master's degree in the British educational system.
